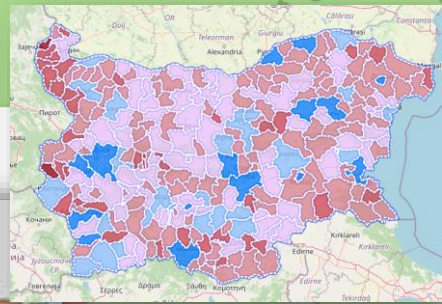

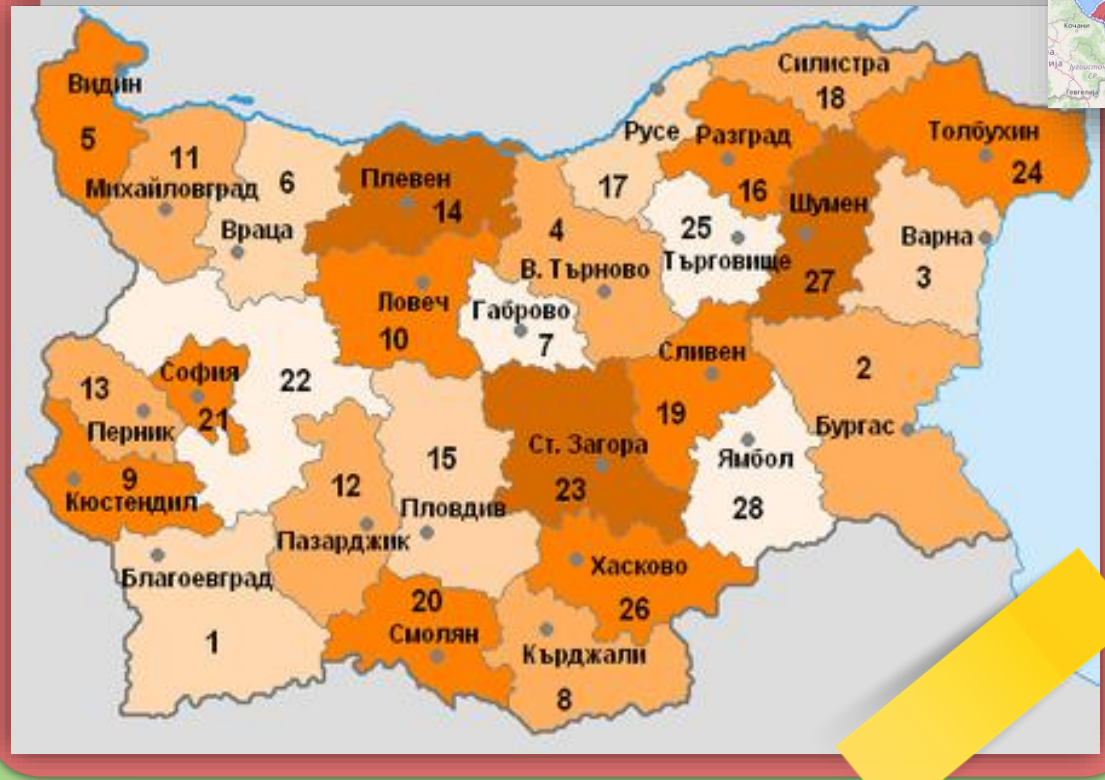

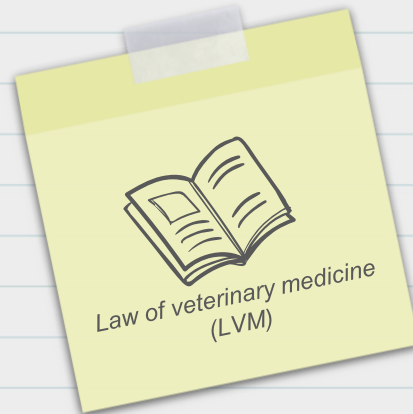
According to art. 51 of the LVM „Animals are to be officially identified, and animal holdings – registered according to art. 137 of the LVM “

art. 137 from the LVM describes:

- documents required when operator applies for registration of an animal holding;
- the procedure for the registration itself.



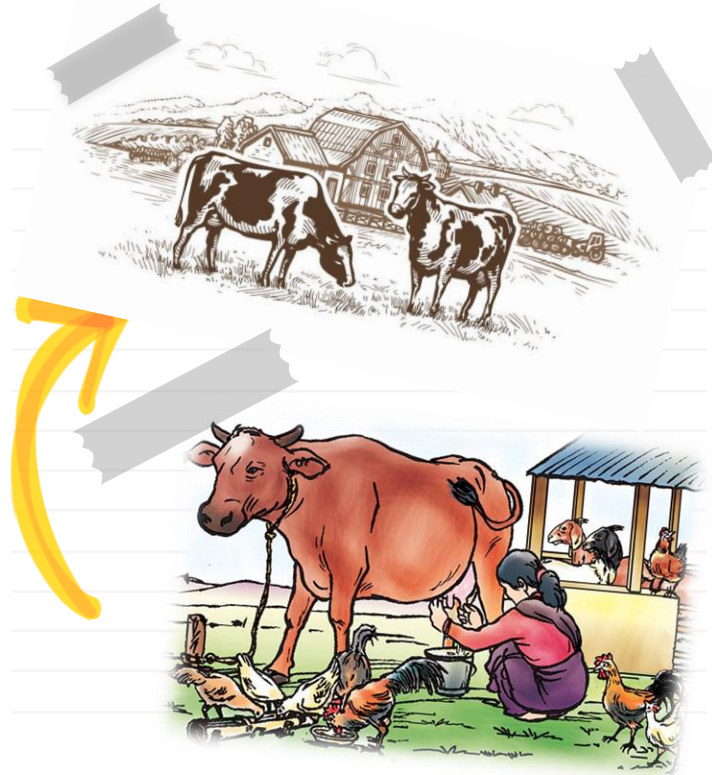
RFSD is the competent authority for the registration



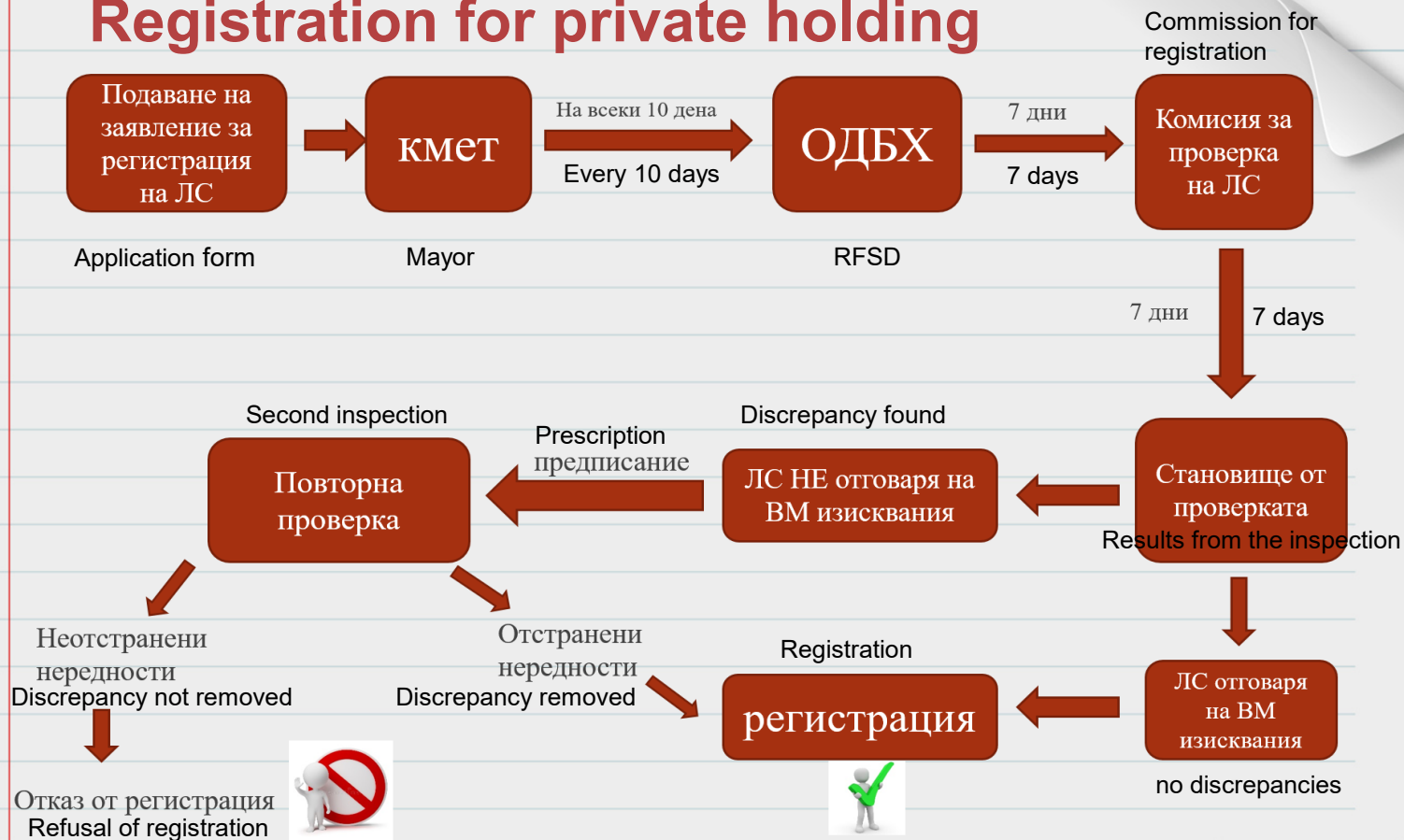
Animal holdings – for livestock

Private animal holdings (only for personal use):

- Up to 2 large ruminants and the offspring up to 12 months of age;
- Up to 10 small ruminants and the offspring up to months of age;
- Up to 3 fattening pigs, different form sows and not castrated males;
- Up to 2 equids and the offspring up to 12 months of age;
- Up to 10 rabbits and the offspring, but no more than 100 in total;
- Up to 50 birds regardless of the kind;
- Up to 100 broilers.

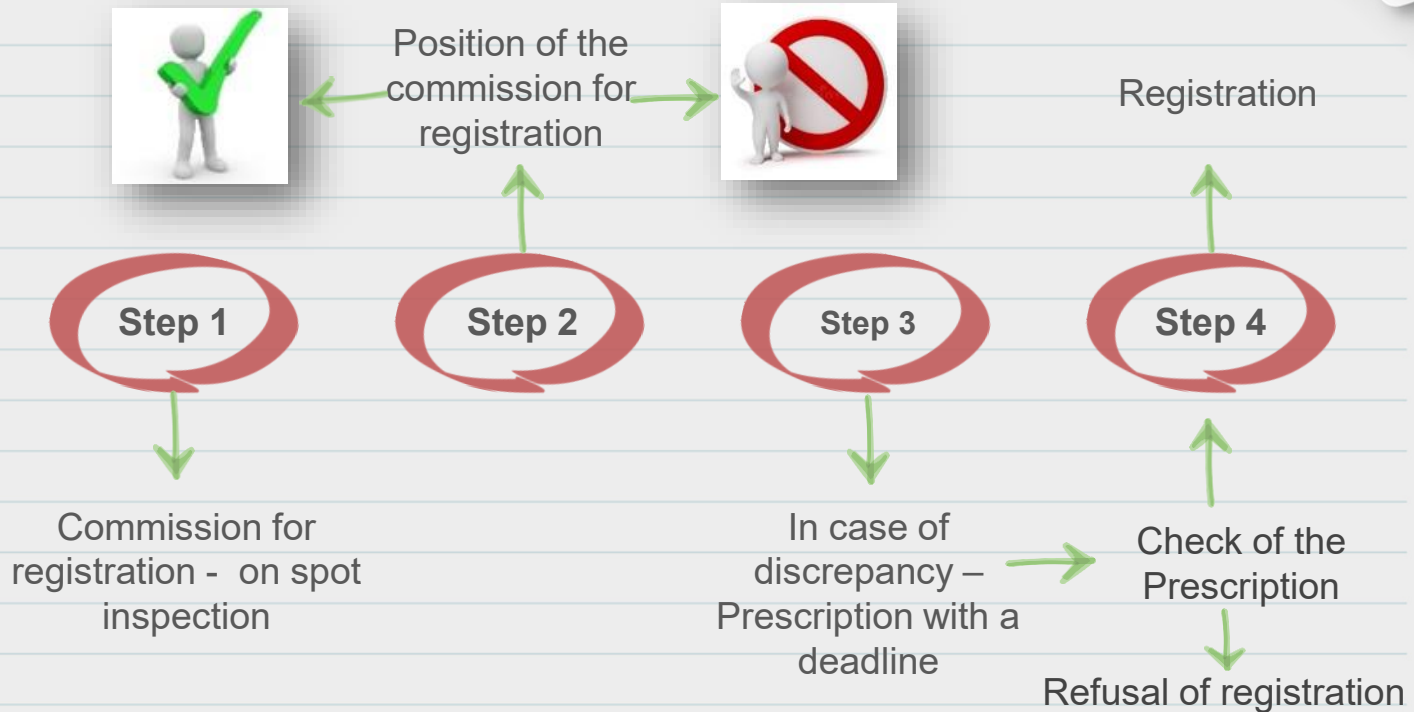

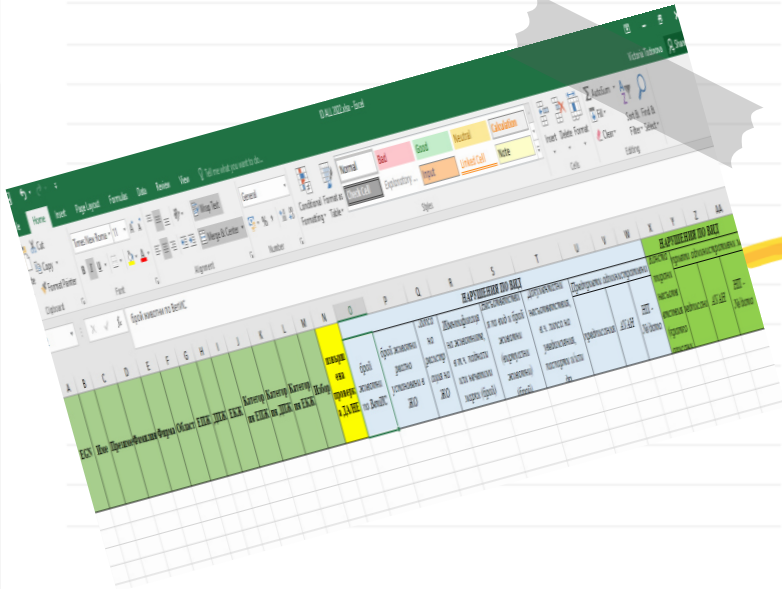

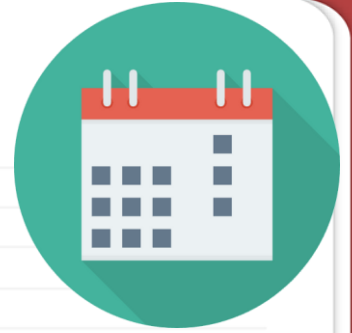
